BP 5125.2

Withholding of grades, diploma, transcripts

If a student fails to return school property, or if he/she has willfully cut, defaced, or otherwise injured any real or personal property, the District may, after affording the pupil of his/her due process rights, withhold his/her grades, diploma and/or transcript.

Such records may be withheld until the student and/or his/her parent has paid for the lost material or damages.

A voluntary work program shall be made available for a student if he/she or the parents are unable to pay for the loss or damage.
