I. Welcome and Attendance

- The Meeting was called to order at 6:10.

II. Adoption of the Agenda

- Rosa Palomares motioned to approve the agenda and Francisco Perez seconded the motion.

III. Adoption of Minutes

- Lilia Rodriguez motioned to approve the minutes and Samuel Barcenas seconded the motion.

IV. Introduction

- Ivonne Glenn introduced Teresa Murillo, board member and Ramon Zavala, Assistant Superintendent Educational Services.



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- Dr. Zavala stated he was happy to see everyone at the meeting and expressed how important the committee is.
- Everyone introduced themselves.

V. Reclassification Presentation

- Ivonne Glenn presented a Power Point presentation on Reclassification.
 - i. The presentation began with a Seal of Biliteracy video.
 - ii. There was an activity following the video asking the representatives what was important for them. DELAC members shared the importance of bilingualism and how powerful it was to see students testaments.
 - iii. During the presentation questions were asked regarding reclassification:
 - a) What is the reclassification goal of the District? The goal of the district are the same as the state goals to meet the percentage required.
 - b) What the difference of reclassification rates between 14-15 and 15-16 school year? Many factors can be attributed perhaps the implementation of EL Achieve. It could also be that several students reclassified in the year 13-14.
 - c) What services are provided to secondary students? ELD classes and intervention classes.
 - iv. An exercise was conducted for parents to understand the reclassification process and its criteria CEDLT levels, Assessment, Teacher recommendation, parent consultation.
 - v. It was explained to parents that this year every school district empirically established assessment criteria.
 - vi. Parents asked what support is different between English learners and RFEP? El students receive services while RFEP students are monitored for up to two years.
 - vii. Board member Murillo asked how switch time and services are monitored? There are teachers EL facilitators and EL Coordinators at each school site that monitor English Learners and there is paperwork associated to the monitoring.

VI. Recommendations

- It was recommended to postpone the LCAP Input to March's DELAC Meeting.
- It was recommended to improve parent outreach in regards to reclassification.
- Recommendation forms were distributed for the representative to ask for recommendations from their ELAC's in the next two months.
