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Introduction

All California public school students must satisfy the California High School Exit Examination (CAHSEE) requirement, as well as all other state and local requirements, in order to receive their high school diploma. The CAHSEE requirement can be satisfied by passing the exam or, for students with disabilities, receiving a local waiver pursuant to *Education Code* Section 60851(c), or receiving an exemption pursuant to *Education Code* Section 60852.4.

School District Legal Requirements for Parent and Guardian Notification

At the beginning of the first semester or quarter of the regular school term, the governing board of each school district is required to notify the parent or guardian of a student regarding rights and responsibilities of the parent or guardian. (See *Education Code* Section 48980 for more information.) Beginning in grade nine, and each year thereafter, students and their parents or guardians must receive notification regarding the CAHSEE requirement through this annual notification process. (See *Education Code* Section 48980[e].) The notification must include, at a minimum, the dates on which the school district will offer the exam, the requirements for passing the exam, and the consequences of not passing the exam. It must also inform parents and guardians that passing the exam is a condition of graduation. If a student transfers to another school district, notification must be given at the time of transfer.
