

Internet Filtering

High-speed internet access is provided to the schools by the District Office. The school district is required by federal law (and by experience and common sense) to filter out as much undesirable internet content as is possible. This is especially important in an instructional setting.

Occasionally however, sites that are of legitimate educational value are blocked accidentally. This is often not because of any District Office policy, but because the Internet filter is a machine and it makes mistakes. It may have filtered out a web page because of a certain word or image and blocked the site inappropriately.
