




<p>NWEA MAP Assessment Grades 2-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics • Reading • <i>Language Usage is optional</i> • <i>Science at grades 5 & 8 optional</i> 	<p>Grades 2-8 Fall Session ends: Nov. 9 Winter Session ends: March 9 Spring Session ends: June 8 <i>Summer Session ends: July 31</i></p> <p>Grades 9-11: <i>may test at Fall and Winter only to focus on SAT, AP, ACT in the Spring</i></p> <p><i>Students may test at anytime (as may be needed for SST or RFEP), but only the most recent score within a window will be saved in the student's Aeries record.</i></p>	<p>MAP scores provide a content mastery score in Math and English. The scores related to a standards based learning continuum which identifies individual student zones of proximal development (what students can currently do with 50% accuracy). The continuum is useful at informing lesson planning and strategic grouping. Scores are also uploaded to Study Island which creates Individual Learning Plans linking students with strategic content across all grade levels. This program provides academic content for our extended day programs but may also be used by teachers during the regular school day for blended learning opportunities as well as short term independent study contracts. Study Island has K through 12 content in English and Spanish in all 4 core academic areas. The browser to administer the MAP is on all chromebooks and rosters sync daily.</p> <p>MAP test information site</p>
<p>Social Emotional Learning Pilot: Grades 3-8</p> 	<p>Grades 3-8 4 administrations per year: First 20 days of school Fall Session ends: Nov. 9 Winter Session ends: March 9 Spring Session ends: June 8</p> <p>(in conjunction with MAP tests at trimesters).</p>	<p>We are in a pilot with NWEA for a social-emotional learning survey that assesses student safety and connectedness. The survey may become a simple add on to the MAP test to streamline collection once the pilot is completed this year. The current pilot will use a browser pushed out on chromebooks and will work much like the current MAP or CAASPP. The survey takes about 10 to 15 minutes. We are piloting with the hopes of developing a quick double check on whether changes in student attitudes/feelings may be detectable to assist connecting students in need with various social emotional supports as part of our MTSS efforts. There will be a chromebook browser and log in card to support test administration. Question Preview</p>

Scores are entered into Aeries through the shared gradebook. The information helps to inform student needs during direct instruction and to identify students needing tier 2 or 3 support. Tier 2 supports may include Lexia, System 44 and Read 180. Taking at least one IBA from the CAASPP digital library is necessary to check the functionality of state testing system, provide students with a preview of test function, and expose students to any accommodations or designated supports that they may have.</p> <p>Interim Assessment Block Information Site</p>

<p>MDTP: Math Diagnostic Testing Project Math 8 and Integrated 3 students</p> 	<p>Math 8 Integrated 3 students</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spring (Date TBD) 	<p>The MDTP is given to help inform students, parents and teachers about a student's readiness to accelerate on our math pathways. Acceleration is allowed from Math 8 to Integrated II and from Integrated III to Calculus. Specific acceleration points have been identified to be supported by our enrichment programs so that students do not skip content.</p> <p>MDTP information page</p>

The RI returns a lexile score and is also the assessment used in Read 180. There is also a Phonics Inventory (PI) available for beginning readers.
