

Dear Parents,

The Morgan Hill Unified School District will be presenting the “Be Seen and Heard” program to all TK-12 students from October 23 through November 10th. This program is presented in the interest of student safety and seeks to provide children an understanding of sexual abuse in age appropriate ways--and more importantly, how to respond to keep safe.

The program is scaled appropriately to different grade levels to broach this difficult topic. Previews of the age span topics are shown below. Parents are also encouraged to watch a brief video message from the author, Victor Pacini, regarding the program. This is a single-day lesson with 4 brief follow up reminders throughout the rest of the year.

On October 19, the district office will be hosting a parent meet and greet at noon with the author of “Be Seen and Heard.” This will be an opportunity for parents to ask any unresolved questions of the author about the program before it is introduced to students.

Following the preview period on October 19th, parents will have the opportunity to “opt out” their children prior to the program being delivered. To help inform that decision, please view the video and look through the program overviews linked below.
