MHELA employees inclusive will have the following benefits:

- a. Longevity increments will be 2.5% of the current salary beginning in the 10th, 15th, 20th, and 25th year of MHELA service in the District.
- b. Dues and Professional Organizations: 0.9% of salary for dues for approved professional organizations.
- c. Degree Stipends: Doctoral Degree: additional \$1500; Master's Degree: additional \$1500; Bachelors Degree for Classified Staff additional \$500. Stipends for degrees are cumulative up to a maximum of \$3000.
- d. MHELA employees have the option to purchase health, dental, vision and other benefits from the vendors offered by the District. Each full-time administrator has \$9,000 annually to use toward health and welfare benefits.
